The Opportunity

Theo Roustopoulos is a third-generation owner/operator of five Pat's Pizzeria locations in New Jersey. Operating what he calls "mom-and-pop small businesses in old buildings," Roustopoulos often looks for ways to replace failing equipment while saving energy.

He turned to Atlantic City Electric's Small Business Direct Install program, which offered incentives to cover nearly 80% of the upgrade costs at three of Roustopoulos's pizzeria locations.

"For example, I needed new HVAC units," he says.

"When you're quoting that out and you realize it's
going to cost you \$30,000, and then a program like

The Process

To help Atlantic City Electric's customers reach their energy efficiency goals, the Small Business Direct Install program uses approved contractors (known as Trade Allies), who start the process by conducting a no-cost energy assessment. This assessment includes a basic inspection of the facility as well as recommendations for energy-saving upgrades and incentives to help pay for them.
